The appellant in appeal No.597/14 has challenged the sealing order dated 19.05.2014 on the ground that matter was remanded back for reconsideration by this Tribunal in appeal No.350/10 with directions to the respondent to provide personal hearing to the appellant. The appellant appeared before the respondent on 13.11.2013 as directed and submitted his reply. Thereafter the Dy. Commissioner of the respondent was transferred and the new Dy. Commissioner issued another notice for hearing for 27.03.2014 which was received by the appellant on 29.03.2014 and was duly replied but the same was not considered and the impugned order was passed and therefore, the directions of this Tribunal contained

in order dated 31.10.2013 passed in appeal No.350/10 was not complied and therefore the matter should be remanded again for providing proper hearing.

3. Ld. counsel for the respondent on the other hand argued that the reply filed by the appellant on 13.11.2013 was duly considered and speaking order was passed and therefore, there is no merits in the arguments of the appellant that proper hearing was not provided.
4. I have perused the record. It is mentioned in the impugned order that appellant appeared before the Quasi Judicial Authority on 13.11.2013 and submitted the reply. Thereafter, the concerned Dy. Commissioner was transferred and the new incumbent issued fresh letter for hearing on 27.03.2014. The appellant received this letter only on 29.03.2014 and thereafter submitted documents. The same were however not considered and the impugned order was passed. The order records that the appellant did not submit certain required documents. However, no opportunity was given to the appellant to submit these documents and therefore the directions contained in the order dated 31.10.2013 were not complied with.

5. Coming to appeal No.596/14, in this case the matter was remanded back on 01.08.2013 in appeal 396/2010 with directions to the appellant to appear before the Quasi Judicial Authority on 19.08.2013. As per the appellant the A.R. could not appear on that day because the Legal Executive had left the company before that and there was no authorized competent person to appear before the respondent on 19.08.2013.
6. Ld. counsel for the respondent submitted that it was the duty of the appellant to appear before Quasi Judicial Authority on 19.08.2013 and therefore proper opportunity of hearing was provided which was not availed by the appellant and therefore, appeal should be dismissed.
7. Record shows that the sealing order dated 24.06.2014 was passed which was after almost 9 months from 19.08.2013 when the appellant was required to appear before the respondent. The appellant did not appear on that day and the respondent issued a letter dated 13.09.2013 asking the appellant to appear before Quasi Judicial Authority on 18.09.2013. The appellant thereafter submitted detailed reply but the impugned order did not take note of that reply and it is stated in this order that no reply as been received.

8. The impugned order even did not mention about the letter dated 13.09.2013 and the hearing dated 18.09.2013. The reply as per office note was received on 14.03.2014 and after three months the impugned order dated 24.06.2014 was passed. In this appeal as well the reply of the appellant was not considered which was submitted much before the order.
9. In these facts, both the appeals are allowed the sealing order dated 26.04.2014 in appeal No.596/14 and the sealing order dated 19.05.2014 in appeal No.597/14 are set aside with the directions to the respondent to give opportunity of personal hearing to the appellant and pass speaking order after considering their reply and documents.
